#### 2. 2020 Annual Budget Review:

**a.** Line Item Review of Annual Maintenance: Board reviewed the Proposed Partially Funded Budget by line item. The Proposed Partially Funded 2020 Budget would remain the same as 2019.

Studio - 3.0%	\$296.53

**b. Review of the Reserve Budget:** Based upon the Reserve Study the 2020 Proposed Fully Funded 2020 Budget using the Component Funding Straight line calculations would be:

Two Bedroom – 5.5%	\$600.45
One Bedroom – 4.0%	\$454.60
Studio - 3.0%	\$350.70
